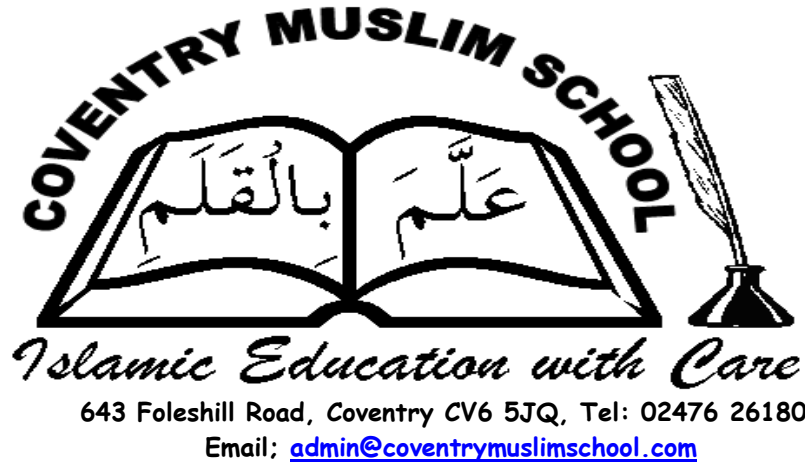

Dear Respected Brothers and Sisters,

Assalaam O Alaikum

Coventry Muslim School is a DCFS registered primary and secondary school delivering the national curriculum subjects supplemented with Islamic Studies, in an environment which encourages an Islamic ethos. The School provides a high quality education, which is reflected in the educational attainment of its pupils, with 70% of students achieving A*-C in their GCSE's. Comparing the results with the national average and the local state school averages for Coventry, we Alhamdulillah are doing much better and our results are above average. We are also achieving well above average SAT's results at both primary and secondary, KS2 and KS3. In 2006 the school was featured nationally in the top 10 league tables, for its value added education. (Guardian Newspaper Feb 2006)

Successful Ofsted Inspection

Coventry Muslim School was recently inspected by Ofsted (Feb 2008). Alhamdulillah the inspection was a successful one and the school achieved a grade of "Satisfactory". To put this into context, the school which operates on a considerably smaller budget compared to state schools, had the same inspection rating as some of the local state funded schools in Coventry. Imagine what we could achieve with an equivalent budget?

Some quotes from the report include:

"Coventry Muslim School provides a satisfactory quality of education overall... with many positive elements. The broad curriculum ensures that the pupils usually enjoy their education."

"In the best lessons, teachers have good subject knowledge, make the lesson objectives clear and move the lesson on at a good pace. There are stimulating activities appropriate to the range of pupils in the class."

"The spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of the pupils is good. Social and moral aspects are particularly strong. Pupils speak positively about the school. They attribute a feeling of safety in the school to the Moslem ethos, to which they are committed"

Looking to a Bright Future

The vision of the Coventry Muslim School is to continue to provide high quality secular and Islamic education, in a conducive environment. To do this we need to continue to develop and extend our existing high standard of provision and address some of the inadequacies stemming from lack of facilities that prohibit this. Some of these inadequacies were cited in the Ofsted inspection report as;

"The premises provide very compact teaching accommodation that is only just satisfactory. The ICT suite is also used as a classroom and there is no science laboratory."

We would like you to share our vision which is "To provide all children access to a high quality education in an environment which develops their Islamic character in order that they become responsible and productive citizens with life skills, to confidently meet the challenges of the future."

We are currently in the process of identifying new sites for relocation of the school as the current premises are not large enough to accommodate the increased demand. We are also not able to expand on the current site to meet requirements for dedicated facilities for PE, Art, Science etc. We urgently need the funds to meet some of the running costs and to purchase property, as soon as suitable premises are identified – to achieve this aim we need the support of you the Muslim community!
